**Declarations MUST BE FILLED OUT IN FULL ~ There shall be five or more entries in each class and four horses to start.**

**There will be an entrance fee of \$20.00 Per Horse/Per Race and no deduction in any race.**

**Make check payable to Orleans County Fair Harness Racing.**

Rights are reserved by the Race Secretary to reject any entry, to declare off due to bad weather, to change program, race elimination heats or divide the class into two divisions each racing one dash for 50% of the purse in any class when more than six horses are declared in to start. Racing is limited to advertised dates. Overnight purses will be divided 50% 25% 12% 8% and 5% ~ If race splits, each dash will race for one half the purse money.

**Requirements for entry to fairgrounds~Certificates must be with the animal:**

- \*\*IN-STATE equines require Official 2017 EIA test record with negative EIA results within 12 months OR a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) with a record of EIA test results, laboratory and date of sampling AND a current Rabies Vaccination between 30 days and 12 months prior to the fair.
- \*\*OUT-OF-STATE equines (imported into Vermont/traveling into Vermont from other states) require (must travel with) a negative official 2017 EIA (Coggins) test record obtained within 12 months of importation AND a health certificate dated within 30 days of import a current Rabies Vaccination between 30 days and 12 months prior to the fair. *If a horse is traveling to various races in Vermont throughout the traditional fair season, the horse owner may acquire an Exhibition Permit from the VT Agency of Agriculture's Animal Health Office which extends the life of the health certificate up to 180 days as long as the horse moves interstate to its first race within 30 days of health certificate examination by the veterinarian-Contact (802)828-2421 for further information.*
- ALL equines over 3 months of age require a current Rabies Vaccination between 30 days and 12 months prior to the fair.
- RECOMMENDED: Vaccination for Flu and Rhino between 14 days and 6 months.

Horses entered at this meet are entered at owners risk and subject to all rules and regulations of the Race Secretary. The owner or agent agrees to indemnify the management, association and volunteers against all claims, demands, suits and expenses arising out of any personal injury or damage to any property caused by his horses, attendants or himself. FREE bedding for your stalls is being provided by Goodridge Lumber & Royer Family Farms. Please bring a wheelbarrow & shovel to leave your stalls as clean as they were when you arrived, your help will give harness racing a bright future in Barton!
