- Adv. Beg - **2, 6, 7, 8, 12, 15, 20, 22, 26**
- Beginner - **3, 6, 7, 8, 13,15, 20 23, 29**
- Mini – **5, 9, 19, 20, 25**
- Champion and Reserve Champion for Beg., Adv. Beg., Junior/Senior combined, and Mini divisions.
Special Hi-Point Award (eligible divisions: Beg , Adv. Beg. , Jr/Sr)
Prizes for everyone! Lead Line will not be placed but all will receive ribbons, all other classes will receive rosettes for 1st - 6th places.

Age/Ability Divisions, all ages as of Jan. 1, 2017:

- **Lead Line**-rider 5-18 with handler 14+, **Beginner**: rider 8-18, W/T only, **Advanced Beginner**: rider 8-18, W/T/limited canter, no canter if combined with Beg, **Junior**: 8-13, W/T/C, **Senior**: 14-18, W/T/C
- **Pre-entry fees are \$8 per class and Post-entry fees are \$10 per class.**

Anyone who pre-enters WITH PAYMENT, FEES, AND ALL PAPERWORK INCLUDED by Friday, August 11 will receive 2 gate passes per horse/rider entry. Passes will be mailed shortly before the fair. No list will be kept at the gate, if you lose or forget your gate admission ticket, you will have to pay to enter the grounds. Passes are good for grounds admission only. Enter through Gate B located on Park Street. You will not be able to enter fairgrounds through the main gate on Roaring Brook Road.

- **No refunds** given for deleted classes, refunds only with vet statement/medical emergency. Please check your entries carefully. We will allow only one class swap-one deleted class for one new class. Additional classes added the day of the show will be at post entry fee.
- **Copies of Negative Coggins, rabies vaccination, Helmet Form and check for fees, needs to be submitted with entry before an exhibitor number will be given. Please submit with entry form.**
- Any beginner rider seen cantering on the grounds will be penalized by either moving up to a division requiring a canter or excused from the show with no refund in fees.
- Riders may not cross enter divisions but can ride both English and Western within your division.
- Chaps are allowed in Western Equitation classes. ASTM/SEI approved helmets and footwear with heels must be worn when mounted. Do not ask to be excused from this rule.
- Classes close after the 3rd call. Exhibitors will enter the ring while the previous class is being given their placings. No refund for missed classes. Please pay attention to announcements for class changes. Classes may be divided if show personnel determine that it is necessary.
- If a hold is required for a class, must be requested at least 3 classes before the class. You will have a short hold time and if it is taking too long, the gate will be closed.
- New England 4-H Horse Show Rules and Guidelines will be followed. A copy will be available at the show. Judge's decisions are final. Parents and exhibitors may not approach judge, please contact show management with questions and concerns.

VERMONT 4-H HORSE PROGRAM EQUESTRIAN HELMET RULE

1. Effective January 1, 1993, **all youth under 19**, participating in any 4-H equestrian activity, regardless of riding seat, shall wear a properly fitted equestrian helmet which carries a current ASTM/SEI approval with secured chin harness properly fastened at all times when mounted on an equine or in a vehicle being pulled by one or more equines.
2. It is the responsibility of the rider or the parent or guardian of the minor rider, to see to it that the headgear worn complies with such approved standards and carries the proper seals, and is properly fitted and in good condition. Due to degeneration concerns. Equestrian and sport manufacturers recommend replacement every five years. The University of Vermont Extension system, Organizing Committees and Licensed Officials or Leaders are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance. The University of Vermont makes no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about such headgear and cautions riders that serious injury may result despite wearing headgear, as no helmet can protect against all foreseeable injuries in equestrian activities.
3. At any 4-H equestrian activity, the official activity manager (e.g. show manager, clinic organizer, club leader) may, at his/her discretion, check a participant's equestrian helmet for proper standards. If the participant is found to be wearing an unapproved, defective or improperly fitted helmet, he/she will not be permitted to participate in any mounted or driving activity until proper helmet is acquired.
4. The approved helmet requirement supersedes all hat and helmet requirements as stated under appointments in the current set of rules and regulations.
