ALL CATTLE AND EXHIBITORS MUST ENTER THROUGH GATE B.

- A. Entry forms must be submitted by Aug. 1 to Lori Before, 152 Prevost Road, Newport, VT 05855
- B. Youth Show is Open to all Youth 18 and under as of January 1 of the current year.
- C. All animals must be properly identified. Registration papers, lease papers, and health papers will be checked at the fair.

PLEASE NOTE:

Animals exhibited must be owned or leased by the youth exhibitor for at least three months prior to the start of Orleans County Fair. All purebred animals must be registered in the name of the youth exhibitor only. Lease forms as proof of project will be accepted for *non owned animals*. All registration papers and lease forms will be checked upon arrival.

- D. When showing, exhibitors should wear solid color pants or skirts and a white shirt or blouse.
- E. All animals must be free from contagious or communicable diseases. Vermont Health Requirements must be followed.
- F. Exhibitors must provide their own hay, grain and bedding.
- G. All animals must be in place no later than 9:00AM Wednesday, and must remain on exhibit **until 4:00 PM Sunday.**
- H. Exhibitors will care for their animals and keep them neat and presentable.
- I. All exhibitors must enter a Fitting & Showmanship class:

***Fitting & Showmanship to be starting at 9:00 AM Thursday**

- 1. Senior-15 to 18 years of age as of Jan. 1 of the current year
 - 2. Intermediate-13-14 years of age as of Jan. 1 of the current year
 - 3. Junior-10 to 14 years of age as of Jan. 1 of the current year
 - 4. Pre-Jr-Up to 9 years of age as of Jan. 1 of the current year
 - 5. Novice-Any youth participating for the first time in the current year and at least 5 years old as of Jan 1 or current year.
- J. Exhibitors may not have any assistance in preparing their animals for the show after arrival at the fair.

FITTING & SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

For Classes 1-4 of Fitting & Showmanship awards will be made on the Danish System of Awards. Premiums will be awarded as follows:

OVERALL GRAND AND RESERVE CHAMPION-(All Junior and Senior champions of all Breeds compete together in this class.)

COW AND PRODUCE-(Cow and one female offspring of any age and must be owned and/or leased by the exhibitor).

GROUP OF THREE-(Animals must have been shown in above classes and owned and/or leased by the exhibitor)

YOUTH HERDSMANSHIP-All clubs and individuals will be routinely inspected twice a day at the fair. Each will be scored on general appearance, conduct, and cooperation. *Please note: an exhibitor can be judged only as an individual or as part of a group/club and exist of at least three animals.. Youth exhibitors in family herds will be judged as a part of the Open Herdsmanship and not as youth exhibitors.*
