Rules and Drop & pick up times

1. Any Past Entries may not be submitted for judging, but may be entered for the for-sale section of floral hall.
2. Items must be submitted by the person creating the article or a family member/ care taker, under creator's name.
3. Amateur and Professional work will not be judged together. (This will include, if money is made each month off your craft).
4. **Drop-offs-** for non-Perishable items may be dropped off on **Sunday, noon to 4pm. Monday, 1pm to 6pm.** Perishable and non- perishable can be dropped off from **9am to 8pm Tuesday. Wednesday Drop off for Only Perishable** Entries can still be dropped off from **9AM to 10:00AM SHARP.** Judging Will take Place From 11. Am to 1PM. Floral Hall will be locked During Judging.
5. **Pickups-** Entries must remain in Floral Hall until Sunday August 20th 2017. Pick up will begin at 6:00pm till 9:30pm
6. **Removal of Entries before allotted times will result in forfeit of premiums unless other arrangements have been made**
7. Articles may be entered for judging and then be marked for sale after judging has ended.

8. **Entry Fees-** for every 5 items will be \$1.00. 10 items \$2.00. For Quilts, larger than a twin entry will be \$2.00 each.

Nursing Home Entries

1. Each Participant should be assigned a number. That number should be visibly displayed on every item made by the participant.
2. Each group of like items should be assigned a name to describe that project (sun catcher). That name should be on tag with participant number.
3. One first, second, and third place prize will be awarded for each Project Category.
4. Premium will be \$3, \$2, \$1- First thru Third place- Paid to the arts and crafts department of the Nursing Home
5. Participants will receive their Ribbons.
